Revised Timeline

During the week of January 15, 2024, MCFD held a series of meetings with partners to outline next steps in the co-development process. In response to the feedback received, MCFD has revised the funding model co-development timeline. Funding model approval and implementation is now targeted for early 2025. The new timeline extends co-development opportunities and provides space to work through additional details on the funding model.
