About the Project

The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus. Six new underground stations will connect communities and neighbourhoods, making it easier and more affordable to live, work, shop, and access services along Broadway.

Construction is anticipated to begin in fall 2020 with the line in service in 2025.
