## Re: Broadway Subway Project Early Works – Utility Relocation Near Cambie Street

### **SEGMENT F: Intersection of W. 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Cambie Street**

Early construction work is taking place in the Cambie Street and W. Broadway area, between December 2019 and March 2020, to relocate TELUS infrastructure in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project, and is anticipated to take place in the following segments:

- Segment A: W. 10th Ave., between Cambie St. and Ash St.
- Segment B: North on Ash St. to W. Broadway
- Segment C: North on Ash St., crossing W. Broadway
- Segment D: North on Ash. St., W. Broadway to W. 8th Ave.
- Segment E: East on W. 8th Ave. to Cambie St.
- **Segment F: Intersection of W. 8th Ave. and Cambie St.**
- Segment G: W. 10th Ave., crossing Cambie St.

**SEGMENT F:** Crews are anticipated to be working in the southbound curb lane on Cambie St. at the intersection of W. 8th Ave. during the week of December 16, 2019, to prepare for additional work at this location in January 2020. Further details will be provided prior to the work in January, and updates will be made available at [engage.gov.bc.ca/broadwaysubway](http://engage.gov.bc.ca/broadwaysubway).



*Segment F: anticipated general work area. Please note the work area depicted may not be exact, and the timing, location, and nature of work is subject to change. Please refer to on-site traffic signage for information about temporary detours.*

Access for cyclists, pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained, as well as residential and business access. Temporary delays and construction noise may be expected during this work.

It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
