

UPDATE: January 13, 2020

Broadway Subway Project Early Works – TELUS Utility Relocation Near South Granville

Beginning in mid-January, through March 2020, early pre-construction work will be taking place in the South Granville area to relocate TELUS infrastructure, in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project, which is anticipated to begin in the fall of 2020.

Early works are required to jointly facilitate construction of an integrated subway station in a new PCI Development, at the corner of South Granville and Broadway (1465-1489 West Broadway). The Broadway Subway Project and PCI Developments are coordinating these works together to increase efficiency and ensure the least amount of disruption.

Starting the week of January 13 through March 2020, work is anticipated at the following locations:

1. West 10th Avenue between Granville Street and Hemlock Street
2. Hemlock Street, between West 10th Avenue and West 8th Avenue
3. West 8th Avenue between Hemlock Street and Granville Street
4. Laneways between Granville Street and Hemlock Street

Prep work will be undertaken during the week of January 13, with construction anticipated to begin during the week of January 20. To minimize disruption, works will begin on West 10th Avenue, east of Granville Street.

Business and residential access will be maintained while work is underway, and businesses will remain open as usual. Street and sidewalk users, including vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists, are asked to follow the directions of temporary on-site signage and traffic control personnel.

It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
