## Utility Relocate near South Granville

### **CROSSING W. BROADWAY AT HEMLOCK ST. – TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES AND NOISE BY-LAW EXEMPTION**

Early pre-construction work is taking place in the South Granville area to relocate TELUS infrastructure in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project, which is anticipated to begin later this fall.

**February 29 and March 1, 2020: crews will be crossing W. Broadway at Hemlock St.** This work is being undertaken on the weekend between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM to minimize traffic impacts. Temporary lane closures will be in effect; however, two-way traffic will be maintained on Broadway. Please refer to on-site directional signage and traffic control personnel.

Noise impacts resulting from construction work are expected, and we apologize in advance for any disruption.

**The City of Vancouver has granted a noise by-law exemption permit for work on Sunday, March 1 between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM (please note timing is subject to change).**

Berto Contractors is completing this work for TELUS under conditions outlined by a City of Vancouver permit.

These early works are required to jointly facilitate construction of an integrated subway station in a new PCI Group development, at the corner of South Granville and Broadway (1465-1489 West Broadway). The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus. The Project is being funded and delivered by the Province of B.C. with contributions from the Government of Canada and the City of Vancouver. It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
