## Utility Relocate near South Granville

### **TEMPORARY PARKING AND LANEWAY ACCESS RESTRICTIONS**

#### **W. 8<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN GRANVILLE STREET AND HEMLOCK STREET**

Early pre-construction work is taking place in the South Granville area to relocate TELUS infrastructure in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project, which is anticipated to begin later this fall.

**During the weeks of March 2 and March 9, 2020:** Crews will be working on W. 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Hemlock Street and Granville Street. Temporary parking restrictions will be in place on W. 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue during this time.

**To maintain safety, access to the alley on the south side of W. 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue (east of Granville Street), will be restricted for approximately two to three days, beginning March 2. Access to parking in the alley will be restricted during this time.** Please follow the direction of on-site traffic control personnel and signage.

Berto Contractors is completing this work for TELUS under conditions outlined by a City of Vancouver permit.

These early works are required to jointly facilitate construction of an integrated subway station in a new PCI Group development, at the corner of South Granville and Broadway (1465-1489 West Broadway). The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus. The Project is being funded and delivered by the Province of B.C. with contributions from the Government of Canada and the City of Vancouver. It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
