

Environmental Assessment George Massey Tunnel Replacement Project

The British Columbia Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (Ministry) is proposing to replace the George Massey Tunnel with a new bridge, improve Highway 99 from Bridgeport Road in Richmond to Highway 91 in Delta, and replace interchanges at Westminster Highway, Steveston Highway and Highway 17A (proposed Project). The proposed Project is subject to review under British Columbia's *Environmental Assessment Act*.

The Ministry submitted its [Application for an Environmental Assessment Certificate](#), which is required before any work can be undertaken on the proposed Project.

There are 60 days for the submission of comments by the public in relation to the Application. The comment period will begin on August 3, 2016 and end on October 3, 2016.

All comments received during the comment period in relation to the Application will be considered.

The intention of seeking public comments is to ensure that all potential effects – environmental, economic, social, heritage and health – that might result from the proposed Project are identified for consideration as part of the assessment process.
