#### Nelson Hydro

- A Unique City Utility since 1896
  - Serves 10,000 customers both within and outside the municipal boundary
  - 1 of only 5 municipal electric utilities in BC
  - The only BC municipal utility with generation
- Customer Base (by count)
  - 41% Residential Rural
  - 51% Residential Urban
  - 8% Commercial and Other


#### Council Commitment to GHG Action


- Signed onto the Climate Action Charter


