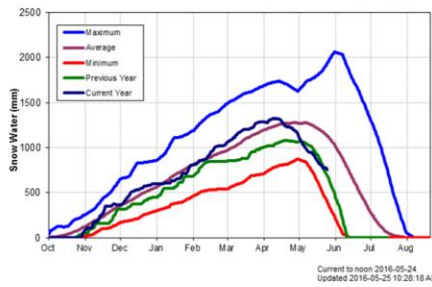

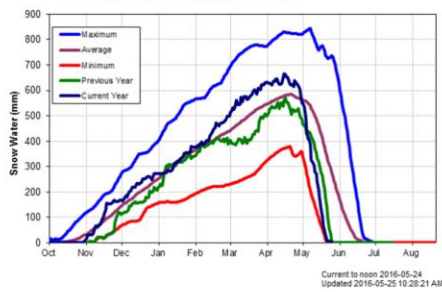

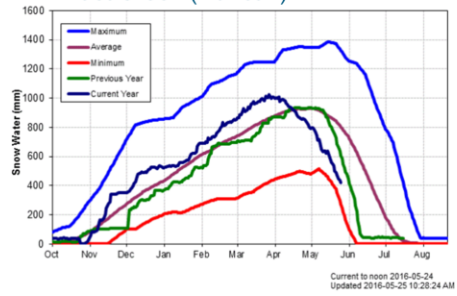


East & West Kootenay Snowpack

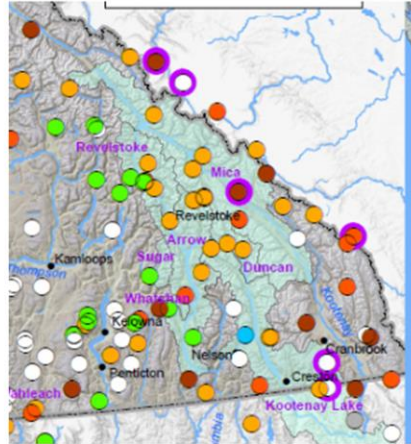
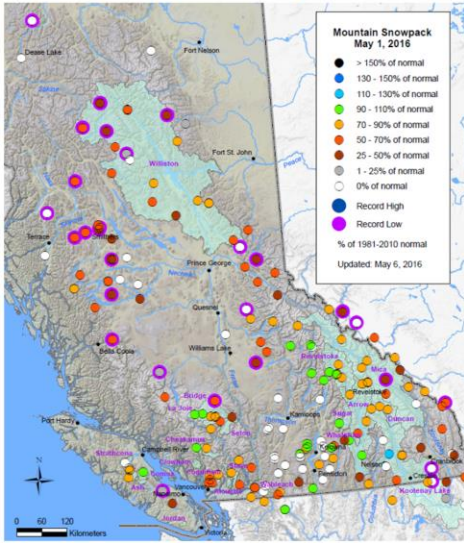

System Snowpack

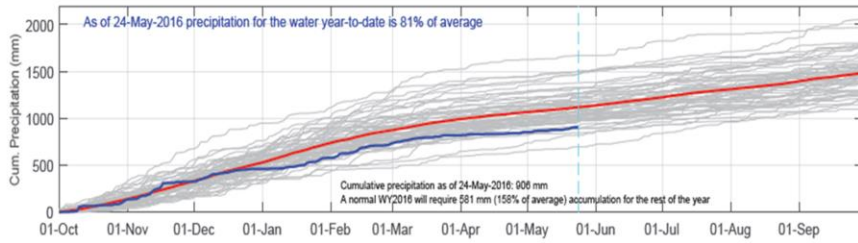
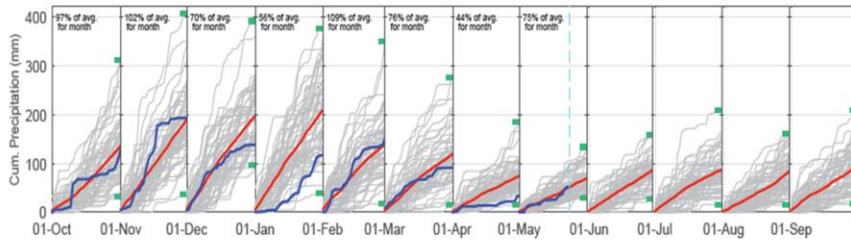


Mica Cumulative Precipitation

May 1st Feb to Sep 2016 Runoff

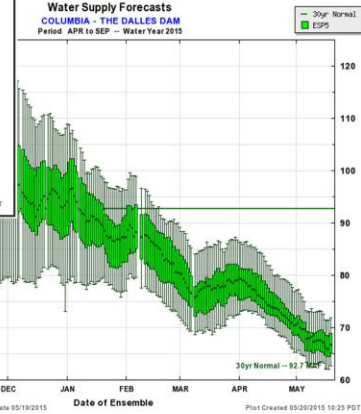
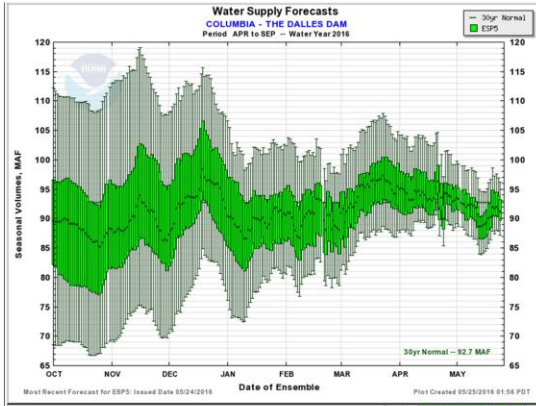

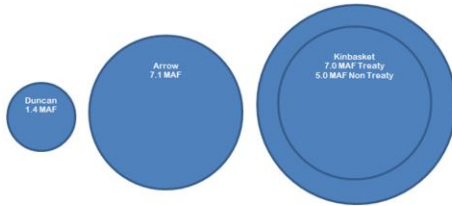
Dalles 2016 (and 2015)



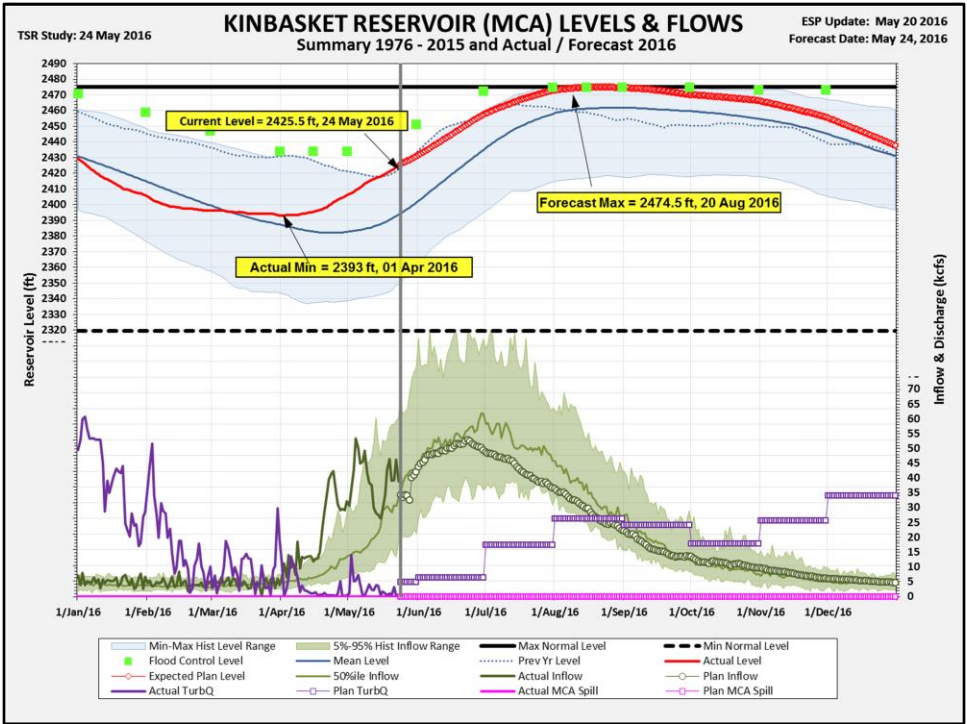
Reservoir Updates



The normal full pool water level for Kinbasket Reservoir is 754.4 metres (2,475 feet). The reservoir can be operated above its normal full pool level if approved by the Comptroller of Water Rights.

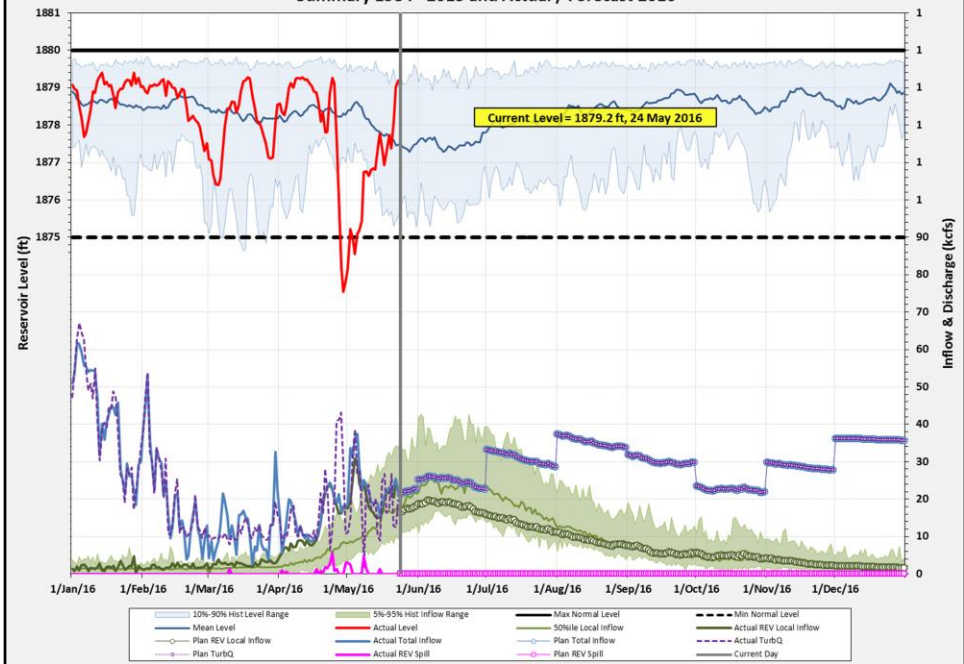


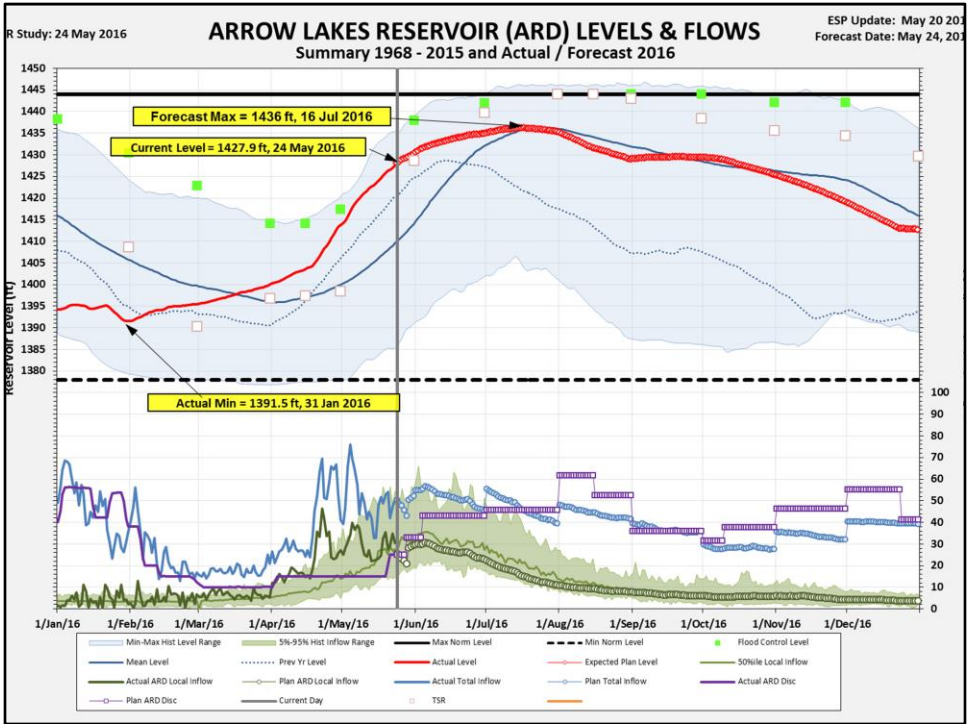

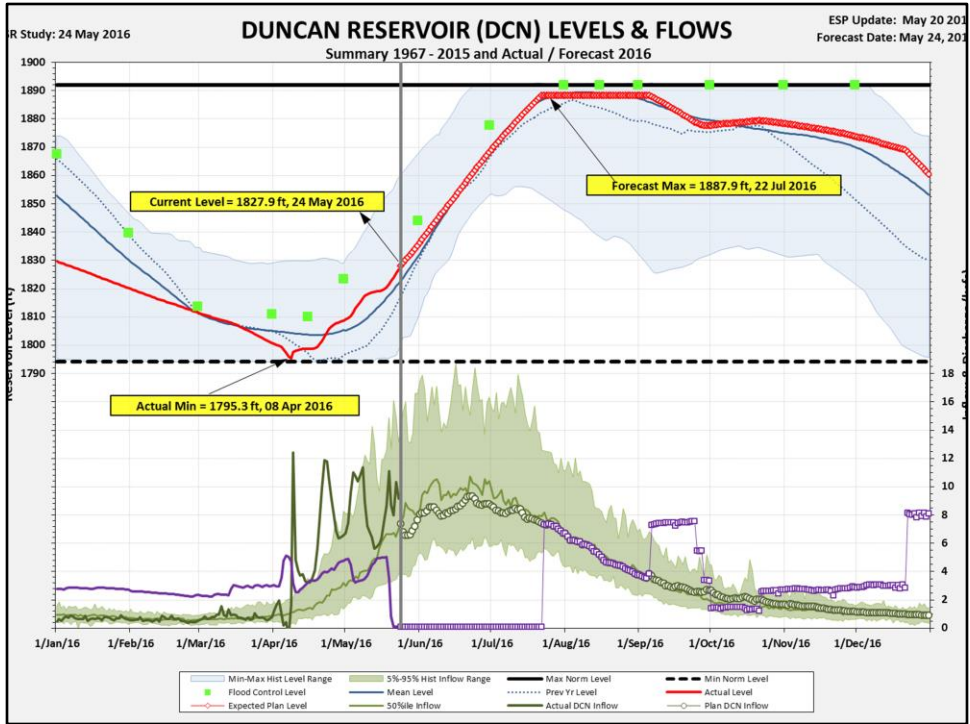


REVELSTOKE RESERVOIR (REV) LEVELS & FLOWS

Summary 1984 - 2015 and Actual / Forecast 2016



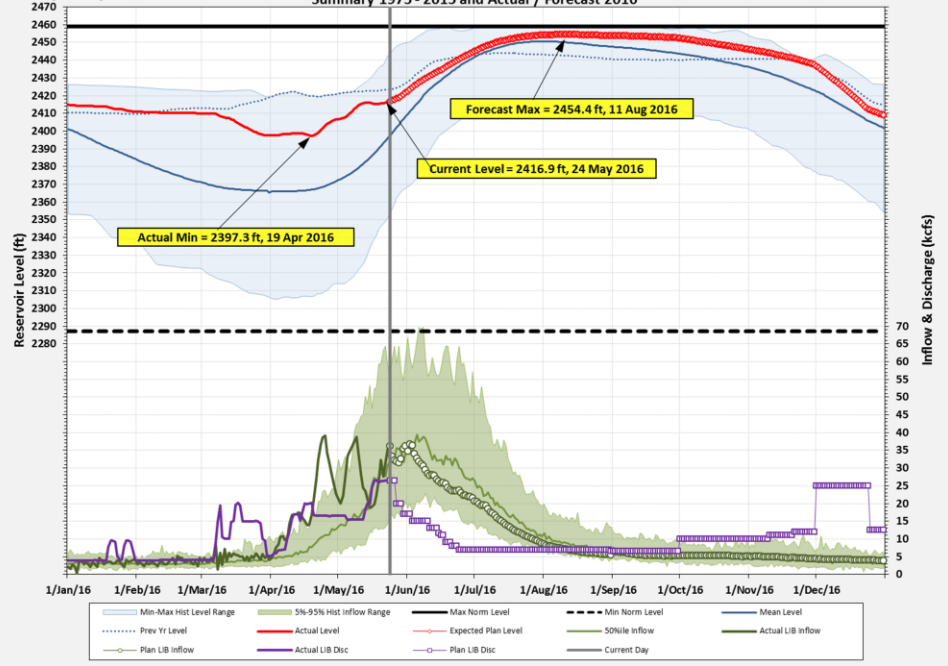




LIBBY RESERVOIR (LIB) LEVELS & FLOWS

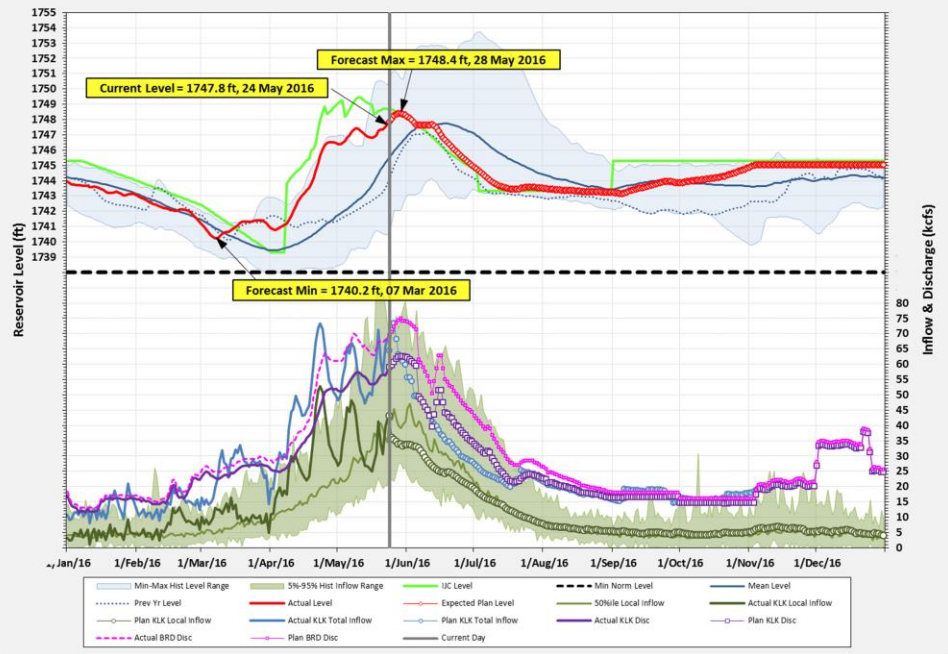
