- Dry conditions (less snow)
 winter 2022/23
- Below average spring 2023 snowpack
- Rapid (record) snowmelt in May
- Lack of summer & fall rain (Provincial drought)
- Columbia River Treaty requires us to send more water to the U.S. during dry conditions

- Held back 2.4 m (8 ft) of water in May 2023
- Increased flows from Duncan in August 2023
- Held back 2.1 m (7 ft) of water in September and October
