Initial Instructions

The intention of the community engagement report out form is for you to share the outcomes of engagements related to services for Children and Youth with Support Needs (CYSN) with the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD). You may be a grantholding organization, a First Nations community, or an organization who is conducting engagement with families or service providers supporting children and youth with support needs.

To fill this out, please:

- 1) Consider if you wish to submit documents and information for one engagement activity or multiple engagement activities. We encourage you to include multiple different engagement activities in one submission if possible.
- 2) Respond to the questions that describe the who, what, when, and where of your discussions and engagement activities.
- 3) Upload any documents you wish to submit. We encourage you to try to combine engagement activities onto one or a couple of documents if possible, and we ask that you only upload each document once. Please do not attach any photos that include people's faces or identifying information. This will result in the immediate deletion of your entry for privacy and confidentiality purposes.
- 4) Respond to the optional questions as desired.

Your responses will help inform and shape the future of CYSN Services. Please include anything that came from your discussions that you think is important.

Identifying Information

If you need help removing identifying information, please consider these points:

Remove people's names, addresses, or specific diagnoses. Instead, use more general identifiers as needed, such as 'they have high medical and equipment needs', or 'they have been looking for behaviour support for 3 years'.

Remove specific professions and employer names. For example, if your community has only one physiotherapist contracted with the ABC Society, do not identify 'the physiotherapist working for ABC Society'. Instead, refer to them as 'a physiotherapist'.
