# **MINING IN BC - KEY PROVINCIAL LEGISLATION**

# **Mineral Tenure**

#### **MINERAL TENURE ACT (MTA)**

- Sets out rules for registering and maintaining statutory mineral titles in BC (i.e., claims and leases)
- Addresses who can register titles, where titles can be registered, the system for registration, and rights conveyed

#### MINERAL TENURE ACT REGULATIONS

 Provides additional rules and details for mineral claims and leases under the MTA (e.g. claim registration, work requirements, fees)

#### MINERAL RIGHTS COMPENSATION REGULATION

• Establishes process related to compensation for expropriation of mineral titles under the Park Act

# COAL ACT AND REGULATIONS

- Governs the tenure, exploration, and development of coal resources
- Operates similarly to the MTA but is specific to coal

#### MINING RIGHT OF WAY ACT

• Operates in conjunction with the MTA to create rights of way to access and develop mineral titles

# Mining

#### MINES ACT & HEALTH, SAFETY AND RECLAMATION CODE

- Regulates all mining activities, including the operation and reclamation of mines with requirements that reduce the health, safety, and environmental risks related to mining activities
- Proposed major mines

   (e.g., metal and coal), major
   expansions/upgrades to
   existing mines, and some
   exploration/development
   projects (e.g., mechanized
   exploration) require approval
   under the Mines Act

#### **MINES ACT REGULATIONS**

 Various regulations under the Mines Act create rules and requirements related to mining (e.g., administrative penalties; mine reclamation fund; fees for permits, inspections, etc.; investigations)

# Revenue

#### MTA & COAL ACT

• Fees collected related to registration and maintenance of mineral titles

# **MINES ACT AND REGULATIONS**

 Fees collected related to, for example, permits, inspections, and certifications

# MINERAL LAND TAX ACT

• Mineral land tax is paid each year by owners of freehold mineral rights

### **MINERAL TAX ACT**

 Sets out framework for tax collected from mine operators based on the "use and depletion" of coal and mineral resources

#### ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENTS

• Agreements between government and First Nations for sharing direct mineral tax revenue

#### NEW FISCAL FRAMEWORK (IN DEVELOPMENT)

• New framework being co-developed with Indigenous Peoples

### ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT & ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT ACT

 Mining activities may require approvals for activities with potential environmental impacts (e.g., waste discharge, emissions, water use)

# FOREST ACT & FOREST AND RANGE PRACTICES ACT

• Mining activities may require a permit or license (e.g. to cut trees)

# WATER SUSTAINABILITY ACT

 Mining activities require approvals for activities such as water use and stream diversion

# HERITAGE CONSERVATION ACT

 Protection of heritage sites and objects can limit statutory access and/or mineral rights under the MTA

### LAND ACT

 Intersections between Land Act – which addresses use of land for community, industrial, and business purposes – and statutory rights granted under the MTA

### **OTHER STATUTES:**

WILDLIFE ACT; DRINKING WATER PROTECTION ACT; ENVIRONMENT AND LAND USE ACT; PUBLIC HEALTH ACT
